

Dear CompEngs,

The following examination formats will be offered during the examination period of the winter semester 2020/21:

- Examinations that take place in presence:

Examinations that take place in presence will be postponed to a date in the period 25th May to 8th June 2021. They will be conducted in accordance with the relevant infection control regulations. Corresponding hygiene concepts are available, their successful implementation was demonstrated during the examination period of the summer semester 2020. Please note that the examination date may change due to further developments regarding the containment of the Corona pandemic.

- Examinations that will take place online:

Online exams will take place in both oral and written form, sometimes there will be a combination of a written exam and a subsequent colloquium. Written exams will be in the form of an open-book or a multiple-choice written exam.

- Examinations that will be replaced by alternative examination forms:

Written examinations that can be replaced by alternative examination forms are conducted via assignments to be handed in.

You can find the information on the format of your exam on the homepage of the examination office.

At the same time, we would like to remind you once again of the possibility of deregistration from examinations, which is possible up to one day before the examination during the examination period of the winter semester 2020/21. Such deregistration will not count for the possible maximum number of deregistrations.

This semester, some examinations will be offered online. The Ruhr-University Bochum has published an official announcement for the implementation of online examinations. You can find it on the homepage of the examination office.

In the case of an online examination, an affidavit will be required stating that you have only worked on the examination using approved resources and on your own. This must be signed and submitted to the respective examiner in the required time and manner.

The free attempt regulation of the winter semester 2020/21 will not be applied in case of attempted fraud. In case of a proven attempt of fraud, the exam will be graded with 5.0 (failed). Further consequences may still follow, including possible exclusion from continuation of studies.
